

Highlights of Logan County Virtual Program:

Register today with an opportunity to change your mind:

Families interested in the Virtual Learning Program, but not certain if this is the best option for your family should go ahead and register for Virtual Learning. You will have 14 days after the semester starts to change your mind and choose another option. Please use the Virtual Application link on your school's website/social media sites or Logan County Schools website/social media sites. Paper copies of the Virtual application is available at your school site.

Each student agrees to the following:

- Abide by all Logan County rules relating to behavior, conduct, and attendance.
- Failure to log into your account and complete assignments may result in withdrawal from the virtual program.
- Respond to the Virtual online teacher, facilitator and school contacts when requested.
- Participate in a weekly TEAMS meeting with the facilitator.
- Take all state or county assessments for assigned grade level/course.
- Complete all courses with passing grades by end of the semester.
- Must enroll prior to the 14th day of each semester.
- Follows all county immunization and screening guidelines.

What Logan County Schools' provides to the Virtual Learners:

- An electronic device and technology support to complete your assignments
- All necessary online curriculum delivered by a WV certified teacher
- Eligibility to participate in sports, curricular and extra-curricular activities, based on school and WVSSAC guidelines
- A facilitator to provide support, progress monitoring, proctoring tests, and ongoing program services as needed
- 5 breakfast meals and 5 lunches delivered to your student, if desired
- Services related to IEP/504, mental health, social-emotional support, tutoring and other school related services will be provided
- Handbook of support
- Confidentiality set by FERPA law
- Weekly face-to-face meetings with Facilitator by TEAMS
- Any instructional materials or supplies needed to complete the online assignments that other Logan County students are provided
- Weekly Newsletter – Facilitator will provide ongoing county school news, so you do not miss out on what is happening at the school in your district
- Support, services, and communication as provided to Brick and Mortar students, delivered by the Grad Coach, Social Worker, Counselor, Principal, and other school staff
